Admissions

All the seats under the convenor quota are filled up through the respective entrance examinations.

Admissions to B.Tech are through EAMCET, and MBA / MCA are through ICET.

M.Tech admissions are through GATE/ PGCET conducted by the affiliating university.

Applicants under category 'B' / Management quota must have secured atleast 60% in the qualifying examination (Intermediate / 10+2 for B.Tech, Graduation for MBA/MCA/ M.Tech).

Those intending to take admission in the management quota may contact the college office.



Infrastructure

The college is setup among lush green surroundings in a pollution free atmosphere, very near to the city in beautiful and spacious buildings with all the necessary equipment for running the existing courses and many more in future. The college is affiliated to JNTU, Hyderabad and approved by AICTE. NBA accreditation is expected in a few months. All the labs are fully equipped and some have extra features than those prescribed by the affiliating university and AICTE.

- ✿ Neat and clean canteen to provide fresh and clean refreshments for the staff and students
- ✿ The college has a health center in the campus. Any medical emergency is attended to immediately by a doctor or the student is rushed to the nearest hospital immediately.
- ✿ The college has a 250KVA backup generator which provides uninterrupted power supply to the entire college.

Library

The facilities provided by the college include a huge library with a subscription to many national and international journals and magazines. A reading room is attached to the library which subscribes to all the leading news papers and latest magazines to help the students update their worldly knowledge. Digital library facility is also provided to access the digital content available in the library.



Faculty

The college has a policy of recruiting only postgraduates as teachers. All the teaching faculty in the college are postgraduates (M.Tech/ MBA/MCA). Some of the faculty are PhD holders, some with a vast research experience, and some of our teachers are currently enrolled in PhD. Our faculty include highly experienced industry personnel from reputed organisations like DMRL, BHEL, ECIL, APGENCO, HMT, ICICI, DEShaw and eminent academicians from the universities : Osmania University, University of Hyderabad, NIT Warangal, Kakatiya University.

The college has established CFDM, a Center for Faculty Development and Management, which provides the necessary planning and training for strengthening the teaching and learning process in the college. This center is a unique feature in a private engineering college as such.

Research Center

A research center has been started in the college guided by an eminent academician to enable industry institute collaborative research in the college. This in turn helps the students in doing projects. Some more research centers are being planned to promote interdisciplinary projects and provide more opportunities for student projects.

Student Centric Environment

Overall student development is focused upon in creating a smart, honest, hardworking, disciplined and responsible graduate.

Success in Exams

- ✂ Modern teaching methods like active class rooms and learner centered teaching are essentially practiced.
- ✂ Regular assignments are given in each subject to make the student learn better and beyond the syllabus.
- ✂ Student attendance is reported regularly both to the student and to the parents.
- ✂ A variety of creative tests are conducted weekly to revise the syllabi taught in that week.
- ✂ Remedial coaching is given to weak students
- ✂ Mentoring is one of the important aspects in a student development. Each student has a faculty mentor who is readily available to share the student's problems and be there to help them in both academic and non-academic issues.

Enhancing Placements

- ✂ Weekly student seminars enhance presentation skills among the students.
- ✂ Technical symposiums, seminars and lectures by eminent academicians and industrialists are arranged regularly.
- ✂ Technical training apart from the regular course work to improve employability of the student.
- ✂ Special placement oriented training from second year.

All round Development

- ✂ Sports and games are given due importance in the college. Each class has a weekly dedicated sports hour and after class hours every day.
- ✂ Extra curricular activities are encouraged through various college clubs.
- ✂ To encourage creative writers the college started a quarterly magazine "Srushti". All the departments are involved in every issue of the magazine.
- ✂ A unique practice in the college has been the college Assembly that is conducted entirely by the students on Monday & Saturday. This helps in removing stage fear and improves the students' presentation skills.

Student projects

Final year projects have become one of the flourishing business these days. This in turn has made the students lazy and contributed to reduction in the employability levels among graduates.

The college has taken an initiative in this regard and has made it **all the projects have to be done by the student in the college.** As a result, all the students of the college do their projects in house guided by a faculty. This results in much better output of the students graduating from the college.

The college also encourages students to take up extra projects apart from their regular academic projects. Some of the projects done by the students (like automated feedback system) are being used by the college.

Professional Activities

Technical groups are formed in the college to enhance the technical awareness among students.

- ✂ The college has institutional membership in IETE, CSI
- ✂ CSI student branch has been started with 150 student members.
- ✂ Open source University meetup (OSUM-a SUN Microsystems Initiative) branch initiated by a student from the IT department has about 200 members currently.
- ✂ All the students are encouraged to take up professional society memberships.
- ✂ Association of Mechanical Engineers is a professional group formed by the Mechanical engineering students
- ✂ EEE students formed a group named "Association of Electrical Engineers (AEE)"

Do's and Don'ts for all the students

The success of an individual is directly proportional to how disciplined the individual is, hence the college emphasises this aspect. The college also follows a dress code in order to eliminate the possible discriminations among the students, and to look more professional.

Do's
